



- Pastors are serving in ways for which they have no training or experience.
- Pastors are doing their best, but unable to keep it up.
- Pastors are worried about ministries that are unable to operate, & if they will be able to operate later.



- Pastors are exhausted. Less gathering does not equal less work.
- Pastors are not feeding their own souls.
- The future is cloudy.
- The collapse of the job & financial markets impacts churches.
- Pastors are physically not healthy.

- Pastors have conformed to a 7day schedule.
- Pastors are unwilling to take time off.
- Pastors don't seek out mental health.
- Pastors are in dangerous spiritual territory.



 Pastors must commit to ministering to their own hearts first.

 Pastors must commit to look out for one another.

Self-care defined:

- Mk 12:31 "Care for others as you care for yourself" (Le 19:18; Mk 12:31; Ro 13:9; Jas 2:8)
- Eph 5:28-29 "a husband's care for himself includes promoting his own ultimate well-being & protecting himself from ultimate harm while excluding selfindulgence."



- 1. Self-care imitates God's care for himself.
 - a) "God values himself infinitely & seeks to have his creation value him as well."
 - b) "God seeks to have his love returned."
 - c) We are told to follow God's example



2.Self-care Imitates God's Care for Us

a)God loves people
b)Jesus affirms the dignity of human nature
c)Jesus showed us humans are worth saving



- 3. Self-care benefits God, others, & ourselves.
 a) Self-care benefits God.
 - "Self-care is a form of love to God in whose image the self is."



b) Self-care benefits others.

- "we must care about ourselves before we can care about others, because our self-care is the model or standard of neighbour-care."
- "The Bible teaches that people who don't love themselves can't love their neighbour, & only those who have their basic needs met can help others."




- c) Self-care benefits us.
- "God made us with a natural tendency to care for ourselves, & this is one of his ways of ensuring that we are cared for."
- "When sin entered into the human race, it brought a self-indulgence that hinders people from caring for themselves."
