<b>SOM-101 Worldview: Foundations of our faith</b>			
	SOM-101-01	Worldview I	After an Introduction on the concept of worldview, this class will examine the basic foundational beliefs of the evangelical Christian church, with a focus on God, Creation, Revelation, and Fall.
	SOM-101-02	Worldview II	This class will examine the basic foundational beliefs of the evangelical Christian church, with a focus on Redemption, Church, Calling, and Re-creation.
	SOM-101-03	Jesus: Who Do Filipinos Think He Is?	This class will examine how Filipinos view Jesus Christ and how that view can be reconciled with the biblical presentation of who Jesus is. How can I bring a biblical understanding of Christ into my ministry?
	SOM-101-04	The Centrality of Jesus Christ in the Redemptive & Transformative Plan of God	
<b>SOM-102 My Church: A Part of God's Plan for Changing the World</b>			
	SOM-102-01	Functional Church	Having studied the basic foundational truths of the Christian church, it is now time for us to examine more closely the church itself. Three basic questions need to be answered in relation to the church, namely What is the Church? How do we identify the church when we see it? and How is the church supposed to engage the world?
	SOM-102-02	Church Engaging Society	This class will examine Jeremiah 29 and how it relates to what the church must do as a community in exile.
	SOM-102-03	Transformational Ministry	This class will examine a theology of Christian Transformational Witness and propose an interrelated system of cooperation among the various structures of society, including church, government and NGOs.
<b>SOM-103 Making Good News Good</b>			
	SOM-103-01	Introduction to the Gospel: The Good News	This class will discuss what Jesus called the Good News -- the Kingdom of God
	SOM-103-02	Good News According to Mark	This class will discuss Jesus as presented by the author of Mark, revisits the COMCA Bible Interpretation tool, and takes a look at a few Markan stories in order to better understand his perspective.
	SOM-103-03	Good News According to Jonah	This class will look at the story of Jonah in order to determine a valid approach for proclaiming the Good News.
	SOM-103-04	Impact-Programs & Good News	This class will compare popular Discipleship and Evangelism programs and discuss their relationship to the Good News.
<b>SOM-104 Building Kingdom Values</b>			
	SOM-104-01	Essential vs Non-Essential	This course will discuss how the church can begin Building a Small Piece of God's Kingdom. This will include understanding and deciding which issues are essential and which are non-essential as we seek to fulfill our mission. It will also begin defining a cell group.
	SOM-104-02	Building Community & Kingdom Values	This course will examine the biblical concept of Community and Kingdom Building. It will also discuss practical ways to build and develop community within a group such as a church or cell-group.
	SOM-104-03	Discipleship vs the Academy	
	SOM-104-04	Core Beliefs & Practices	This course will be a seminar on how to develop a series of Core Beliefs and practices for your ministry. Practical examples will be given and a sample document will be developed.
<b>SOM-105 Truth telling</b>			
	SOM-105-01	Truth-Telling in a World of Uncertainty	This course will discuss the biblical concept of Marturia as being God's prophetic voice by engaging society with biblical truth. Marturia is advancing the cause of Jesus Christ by bearing witness to the transformation the Good News brings.
	SOM-105-02	Hotel Rwanda: A Truthful Response	During this class we will watch the movie "Hotel Rwanda" and discuss some of the ideas relating to truth telling that come out.
	SOM-105-03	Truth Telling: Practical Matters	This class will examine Joshua as a practical example of truth-telling. Connections will be made between Joshua's truth-telling experiences and the students' truth-telling experiences with the goal of developing a personal theology and practice of truth-telling.
<b>SOM-106 Sent for Service</b>			
	SOM-106-01	Sent for Service - Biblical Definitions	This course will discuss the biblical concept of Diakonia as being the church's way of showing the love of God to people both inside & outside of our faith community. It will also examine a new understanding of what Diakonia means.
	SOM-106-02	Sent for Service - Theology of Disaster	This course will develop a theology of disaster. It will also examine & discuss models of how the church can intervene in disaster relief & development.
	SOM-106-03	Sent for Service - Prophetic Diakonia	This course will discuss the biblical concept of Prophetic Diakonia that applies diakonia not only to the voice the church has inside its four walls, but extends that voice to the far limits of the world.
<b>SOM-107 Preaching and Teaching</b>			
	SOM-107-01	Making the Bible Relevant	This class will introduce the concept of Bible interpretation and teach students the COMCA method. Opportunities for student teaching will occur during this class.
	SOM-107-02	Preaching Your Worldview	This class will introduce the concept of preaching and teach students its various techniques and styles.
	SOM-107-03	Preaching Lab	Students will actually preach a sermon in this class and be evaluated by their classmates and instructors.
<b>SOM-108 Foundations of Mission</b>			
	SOM-108-01	Pastoral Ceremonies	This class will examine the three basic pastoral ceremonies in the Philippines - Kasal, Binyag, and Libing - and discuss the theology of each event, the structure of each event, and practice each event with the hope of developing a missional/functional theology of KBL.
	SOM-108-02	Church in Philippine Context	This class will examine the church in the Philippines today by looking at historical factors leading to its development and seek to discover ways to make this church more missional/functional.
	SOM-108-03	Word, Work, & Wonder	This class will develop a framework for understanding the Holy Spirit in light of Biblical and Historical Christianity.
<b>SOM-109 Structural Evil</b>			
	SOM-109-01	Structural Evil: An Introduction	This class will examine the concept of Structural Evil including its definition and causes and will look at Christian responses to it.
	SOM-109-02	Structural Evil: A Framework	This class will provide a framework for understanding Structural Evil.
	SOM-109-03	Structural Evil: Principalities & Powers	This class will examine Colossians 1 in developing a theology of Structural Evil. Special emphasis will be given to Jesus' work on the cross as including the "spoiling" of the principalities and powers. Students will be asked to provide a definition and examples of principalities and powers in the world today.
<b>SOM-110 Theology of Money</b>			
	SOM-110-01	Poverty & Prosperity: Which is the Christian Way?	This class will examine two common Christian beliefs regarding money & seek to find a Biblical balance between the two.
	SOM-110-02	Faithfulness with Resources: Stewardship Education	
	SOM-110-03	Tithing & the Christian
